Bildraum Studio at Brotfabrik Wien

A spacious studio as well as an inspiring meeting place: The collecting society Bildrecht is giving momentum to Vienna's art scene with **Bildraum Studio**. **Bildraum Studio** opened in 2018 and is located at the heart of Brotfabrik Wien's cultural area. With 170 sqm of workspace, the studio offers the opportunity to realize and present large-scale works, as well as expansive projects.

For a period of five months **Bildraum Studio** will be available to a freelance artist who will be chosen by a jury of experts.

Space for art projects

In addition to the spacious workroom with floor heating, the studio includes a separate sleeping area, a fully equipped kitchen, bathroom and toilet, storage space and an adjacent art terrace. The freely accessible art terrace (50 sqm), which is located directly in the inner courtyard of Brotfabrik Wien, promotes a lively exchange with the local creative scene and offers visitors to Brotfabrik a low-threshold access to the activities at **Bildraum Studio**.

The competition is open to freelance artists in the following disciplines:

Painting | Photography | Sculpture | Installation | Performance | Media Art | Graphic Design | Art & Science

The applicants consent to one solo exhibition, as well as to the participation in fringe events of Brotfabrik Wien's cultural programme, such as Open Studio Days and/or the annual Herbstfest (Autumn Festival), with organizational support by Bildrecht. Applicants should be able to communicate in German or English.

Application requirements

- All applicants must have been working as freelance artists for at least three years.
- Austrian residents can apply with a project draft.
- Artists from abroad can apply with a project draft that should bear reference to the host country Austria.

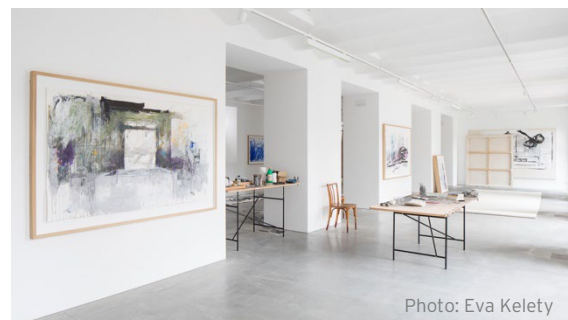

Application and benefits Bildraum Studio

Application portfolio

The complete application in German or English language includes:

- **Application form** completed and signed
- **Application letter** including project draft
- **Catalogues and / or portfolio;** in the field of media art / performance also a corresponding data carrier for works, exhibitions and projects of the last years incl. information on dimensions, year of origin and material / applied technique
- **Artist's biography** incl. contact details (address, telephone number, e-mail address, website)

Conditions Bildraum Studio

- After having been chosen by the jury, the studio will be available to the guest artist **free of charge for five months.**
- The studio has **170 sqm** of working space with sleeping area, kitchen, bathroom and WC, storage space as well as an adjacent 50 sqm art terrace.
- The guest artist will receive a one-off subsidy of 1,500 euros for **material costs.**
- **Internet access, WLAN and basic cleaning** on a monthly basis are included in the use of the studio.
- The guest artist and the project realized in the **Bildraum Studio** will be **publicized by Bildrecht.**
- The residency of the artist and the solo exhibition and/or side events at **Bildraum Studio** are publicly announced by Bildrecht.
- A budget of 500 euros is available for **exhibition costs.**

Bildrecht will inform the applicants of the jury's decision by the end of November 2023. The jury's decision cannot be appealed.

The submitted documents can be collected personally from the Bildrecht office from December 2023. The application documents will be returned by post at the applicants' expense and only after written reclaim.

The personal data of the applicants obtained through the submission will be used exclusively for the decision on the open call of Bildrecht and will not be made available to third parties.
